







Initial: This morning, soldiers and numerous settlers attacked residents of the village of Khalat al-Daba' in the Yatta Pass, in the area defined by apartheid as "Firing Area 918," and arrested three residents and two solidarity activists.

The attack began after two settlers, apparently from the Havat Ma'on outpost, invaded private land belonging to residents of Khalat al-Daba with a herd of sheep.





2/3 Three residents who came out to ask them to leave the area were severely attacked by them with clubs, and then attacked again by soldiers who came to support the invaders. After being beaten, the Palestinians arrested them and the two solidarity activists and took them to the military base in Susiya.


The village of Khalat al-Daba is under the control of the Zionist ethnic cleansing apparatus, and the attack comes as part of the increased efforts to expel the village's residents, who have been attacked by Zionist militias several times this year, and just in the last month were forced to watch the destruction of their homes, property, and fruit trees with bulldozers and state-owned demolition equipment.
